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## **SUMMONING FIRST AID**

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## **ALL EMPLOYEES MUST REPORT AND HAVE ANY INJURY/ ILLNESS TREATED BY FIRST AID IMMEDIATELY**

### **MINOR INJURY/ ILLNESS**

Meet the First aid Attendant where the first aid kit is located. First aid kit is located at:

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The First Aid Attendant (with the consent of the injured worker) will make the decision whether the worker should be transported to medical aid.

The Attendant's decision of treatment or transport must not be overruled. The Attendant, however, does not have the authority to overrule a worker's decision to seek medical attention.

### **SERIOUS INJURY/ ILLNESS**

Dial: 911

Arrange to meet the First Aid Attendant at the scene. Keep patient calm and still. The First Aid Attendant will make the decision whether an ambulance is required:

If an ambulance is required (injury is critical or severe) stay calm, speak clearly and relay the following information:

- Location of patient (*name of worksite, address entrance to use etc.*);
- How to get to the patient;
- Someone will be meeting the ambulance and directing them to the patient;
- Contact phone number so dispatch can call back;
- Mechanism of injury (*what happened*);
- Known injuries to the patient (*fractures, conscious, heart attack, etc.*).

If transporting the patient will not aggravate the injury, the First Aid Attendant will use (*city cab, company vehicle etc.*)
